


COSA BELLISSIMA Montepulciano d' Abruzzo DOC

Cosa Bellissima is focused on the vineyards to achieve equilibrium in the vine in order to best express the characteristics of the territory, rather than achieving a specific yield. This approach is continued in the winery, where all techniques are oriented to preserve the freshness and distinct flavors of the grapes as they naturally occur. The Abruzzo region is known for its wildlife parks, and quality olive oil but best known for Montepulciano d' Abruzzo wine. To increase quality, we have decreased crop yields and aged the wines in barriques (50-gallon French barrels).



The intense ruby color gives way to a vinous and pleasant scent with a delicate bouquet. Predominant flavors of cherries and red berries balanced with hints of black pepper, chocolate and tobacco, woven with a silky and mature tannin texture.



Ideal pairings include classic Italian dishes such as tomato-based pastas, pizza and spicy Italian sausage and pepperoni. Also delicious with red meats, or uncork it with vegetarian favorites like mushrooms, red or black bean dishes, and rich roasted vegetables.
